RE: Payment for student work done for CAG

As stated in the May, 2003 minutes, the Pine River Superfund Citizen Task Force agreed to pay a total of \$5,750 for services that will help the CAG organize, review and exhibit documents, correspondences and important data gathered over the past 5 years (and more). The job descriptions which were presented to the CAG as a whole along with the names of the workers are as follows:

Joan Stewart: Organize and review any and all documents associated with CAG activities which includes: all correspondences, past research, minutes, memoranda, FOIA'd documents, technical updates and communications from U.S. EPA, MDEQ, MDNR and other state and federal regulatory agencies and the CAG/TAG. In addition to organizing and reviewing these documents, Ms. Stewart is responsible for developing a database that will make the documents accessible to any and all interested persons. (\$2,000 agreed to by CAG)

Danielle Poulsen: Review, organize and revamp existing website (<http://pineriver.alma.edu>). This includes creating a new interface and expanding the site to include more and different aspects to reach a wider audience and to make interaction with the site and its contents more "user-friendly." Also, Ms. Poulsen will enter in more documents as part of an attempt to get as much information on the site and make it accessible as possible. (\$2,000 agreed to by CAG)

Anne Love: Review and analyze existing data on incidents of unusual cancers and other ailments to dogs and cats in the greater Gratiot County region to see if there is a relationship between health and proximity to sites contaminated by Velsicol and other pollutants in the Gratiot County area. (\$750 agreed to by CAG).

In addition to these workers, the CAG agreed to pay two St. Louis high school students \$500 each for helping Ms. Stewart, Ms. Poulsen and Ms. Love in their work.
